Did you know ...

- calves can lose up to 8 – 10 % of their body mass in fluids when they suffer from diarrhea?
- diarrhea is the No. 1 cause of losses in calf sheds?
- acute episodes of diarrhea cost over € 260?

Diarrhea causes heavy losses of fluids and electrolytes and excessive dehydration can be life-threatening for young animals. Even if calves survive the consequences of diarrhea-related dehydration, their subsequent performance remains lower.

What does the solution look like?

MiaFirstAid P is a dietary feed supplement for calves to stabilise physiological digestion, fluid retention and electrolyte metabolism.

- MiaFirstAid P dissolves rapidly in water and milk and is well accepted
- tannins and other special, indigestible plant fibers counteract digestive disorders
- rapidly available energy, supporting electrolytes and innovative yeast cell wall extracts promote calf development

How do I use MiaFirstAid P?

- for acute diarrhea dissolve 1 sachet (100 g) in water or milk twice daily until digestion has normalised
- for slight diarrhea dissolve ½ sachet (50 g) in water or milk twice daily
- goats and lambs: dissolve 10 g (sheep and goats) and 5 g (lambs) in milk or water twice a day until digestion has normalized
